## RACE CATEGORIES

Championship Classes:

Elite Men: 19 & over. Junior Men: 17 & 18.

Elite Women: 19 & over. Junior Women: 17 & 18.

These categories are for top level competitors and require UCI sanctioned license.

If fewer than nine riders registering for Junior class, they are combined with Elite class.

Challenge Classes:

Boys/Men: 5-7, 8-9, 10-11, 12-13, 14-16, 17-29, 30 and over  
Cruiser 12 under 13-29 30-39 40 and over

Girls: 5-8, 9-10 11-12 13-14 15 and over

These categories are for intermediate and advanced level competitor. These riders must purchase a UCI sanctioned member organizations license.

If fewer than five riders registering for this class, they are combined with the next older age class.

Age Determination:

The age category is determined by the rider's age as of the 31st of December, 2009.

Pool 2,250CHF for each round. Elite men

Pool 750CHF for each round Junior men/Elite Women

750CHF for Junior Women
