RACE CATEGORIES

Championship Classes:

Elite Men: 19 & over. Junior Men: 17 & 18.

Elite Women: 19 & over. Junior Women: 17 & 18.

These categories are for top level competitors and require UCI sanctioned license.

If fewer than nine riders registering for Junior class, they are combined with Elite class.

Challenge Classes:

Boys/Men: /Cruiser /Girls:

These categories are for intermediate and advanced level competitor. These riders must purchase a UCI sanctioned member organizations license.

If fewer than five riders registering for this class, they are combined with the next older age class.

Age Determination:

The age category is determined by the rider's age as of the 31st of December, 2010 .

Awards 1-3 each class for each rounds(Challenge)

Prize money:

Pool 170000 Yen for each round. Elite men

Pool 750 Yen for each round. Elite Women
