RACE CATEGORIES

Championship Classes:

Elite Men: 19 & over.

Junior Men: 17 & 18.

These categories are for top level competitors and require UCI sanctioned license.

If fewer than nine riders registering for Junior class, they are combined with Elite class.

Challenge Classes:

Boys/Men: 5-7, 8- 9, 10-11, 12-13, 14-16, 17-29, 30-34, 35 and over

Girls: 7 & under, 8-11, 12 and over

These categories are for intermediate and advanced level competitor. These riders must purchase a UCI sanctioned member organizations license.

If fewer than nine riders registering for this class, they are combined with the next older age class.

Age Determination:

The age category is determined by the rider's age as of the 31st of December, 2005.

Awards 1-8 each class for each rounds

Prize money:

Pool 2,250.00CHF for each round. Elite men only.

RACE ENTRY FEES

50.00CHF for Elite / Junior men for each rounds

30.00CHF for Challenge class for each rounds
